## April Homework Helper




### Reading

 This month we will be revisiting how to compare and contrast two things in a passage or story. This may include comparing characters or other objects within the story. Another idea is to compare two books or stories with each other.

### Math

 This month we will begin to explore how to measure length and area using standard and nonstandard units. Your child may need access to a ruler at home for assignments. They will be practicing how to estimate to the nearest inch or centimeter and how to find exact measurements too. Remind your child that inches are bigger than centimeters. A good way to practice measurement skills at home is to measure small objects around the house in both inches and centimeters.

### Writing

 This month we will be focusing on the concept of homophones. **Homophones are words that sound the same but are spelled differently and mean different things (sun-sun, write-right, to-too-two).** We especially want to focus on **their, there, and they're**, as this is one of the most difficult homophones to use correctly writing.

However, also please continue to have your child work on remembering their capitals and punctuation marks in their writing.
