January Homework Helper


Reading

 Listen to your child read any part of their books or reading passages aloud. Have your child recall facts and details about what they read. This may include character names and actions, and the events that are taking place in the story. *Students reading chapter books should practice recalling details after every couple of chapters.

Math

 This month we will continue practicing how to subtract two 2-digit numbers with and without regrouping. Make sure your child's numbers are lined up and remind them to begin with the ones columns to subtract first. We will also be starting to learn about **money**. This will include recognizing coin values, skip counting using coins, figuring out money equivalents, and adding and subtracting money. There is a section on the Second Grade Portaportal under Math for Money games for additional practice!

Writing

 This month we will continue to focus on **punctuation**. It is important that your child remembers that every sentence ends with a mark. We will also be exploring how to vary our punctuation when we write to show expression. Take a look at the written part of your child's homework. Have them double check for:

Punctuation - periods for telling sentences, question marks for asking sentences, and exclamation points for excited sentences.

* Don't forget to continue working on having your child remember capitals in their writing!
