Reading

 Listen to your child read any part of their books or reading passages aloud. Ask: Who is the passage about? What is the most important thing that happened?

Math

 This month we are learning how to read and create graphs. We will also be beginning to learn how to add two-digit numbers. You can help your child with their addition skills by making sure their numbers are lined up and remind them to begin with the ones columns to add first. There is a section on the 2nd grade portaportal under Math called Addition Games. There you will find many games to practice addition skills!

Writing

 We are starting to focus on important writing skills a little bit at a time. This month we would like everyone to focus on **capitalization** and **punctuation**. Take a look at the written part of your child's homework. Have them double check for:

Capitals - at the beginning of the sentence and for all proper nouns (names of people or places)

Punctuation - periods for telling sentences, question marks for asking sentences, and exclamation points for excited sentences.
